

Checklist for authors*:

General

- The article has title in English or Esperanto (if the original language of the article is other than this two, it must be translated, at least to one of these languages)
- Article has an abstract in English or Esperanto (if the original language of the article is other than this two, it must be translated, at least to one of these languages)
- Article has a specified author and address for correspondence (Name, Surname, and e-mail address)
- Article has keywords in English (no more than six)
- All illustrations, plots and tables (apart from being embedded in text or marked in text) are saved in native format, and submitted in separate files along with the manuscript
- Along with the article – forms from interrev.com are also filled and submitted

Formatting

- Text is in a single column format, without redundant spaces, comas, full stops, end of the paragraph signs, tabulation signs in the beginning of the paragraphs
- No words are hyphenated
- Paragraphs are clearly separated from each other, indentations are not made by multiple spaces
- All illustrations, plots and tables are saved in a resolutions suitable for printing (200-300 dpi)

Other

- References are cited in square brackets e.g. [1,2,3] and point to a separate part of manuscript called „References”
- References are made in ACS style ex.
